Independent Walk Routes

Your guide to great walks in Selton













A perfectly scenic walk through rural Ince Blundell, across farmland and wooded areas. This walk is a real escape from the hustle and bustle of daily life.

Route directions

- > Start at Ince Blundell Village Hall Victoria Road, Ince Blundell L38 6JE
- With the village hall behind you turn left and walk along Victoria Road. When you reach the bend in the road (Victoria Road merges with Back O The Town Lane here), cross over and take the road directly opposite you (this is a continuation of Victoria Road).
- > Walk along here until you reach a wooden gate, go through the gate and onto the footpath, through a wooded area and out into open farmland.
- At the end of this footpath turn left and continue along this road (Cross Barn Lane). Then turn right at the end Cross Barn Lane onto Back O The Town Lane.
- Walk along the lane which merges with Park Wall Road and alongside a high wall (taking care as the pavement is narrow).

- When you reach Carr Side Farm, Carr Side Lane on the opposite side of the road (it has stone gateposts and is tree-lined). Cross over and walk down the lane, past the farm buildings and houses.
- After the last house on your left there is a signpost, go left here and follow the perimeter of the field, the path bends round to your right past a wooded area to your left and then a ditch. At the end of this field there is a wooden footbridge, cross over the bridge and continue along the path. The path then bends round to the left. At this point the path turns into a farm track with a wooded area to the right of it.
- At the end of the track turn left and walk along the road (Carr House Lane), past the houses. At the end of Carr House Lane turn left again onto Victoria Road and back to the Village Hall.


