Independent Walk Routes

Your guide to great walks in Sefton













A quick and easy 30 minute walk, taking in the pastel painted houses at Crosby Marina and panoramic coastal views. It's great for all ages and abilities.

Route directions

- > Start at the Royal Hotel, Marine Terrace, Waterloo, L22 5PR
- With the hotel behind you turn right and walk along Marine Terrace. Cross over a small side road (also Marine Terrace). and carry on. Cross over South Road.
- Marine Terrace merges with Marine Crescent at this point. Pass by Wellington Street (no through road) on your right.
- Marine Crescent continues onto Adelaide Terrace here, Carry on along Adelaide Terrace and pass by Blucher Street (no through road) on your right.
- Adelaide Terrace continues onto Beach. Lawn at this point. Cross over to the other side of the road.
- At the bottom of Beach Lawn there is a footpath, walk down the footpath. At the end of the footpath turn left onto Harbord Road. The road ends here and another footpath begins.

- Take the footpath. After a few short steps you will come to a crossroads, go left here and carry on along this footpath, it snakes its way up to a wooden bridge. Go over the bridge and carry on through the dunes until you reach the Promenade.
- Turn left onto the Promenade and walk along it until you reach a sandy path (with grass banks either side of it) to your left, this leads you back through the dunes and onto the Marina (you should be able to see the two lakes ahead of you).
- Take this footpath, passing between the two lakes and where the footpaths fork take the left hand footpath that leads up to the pedestrian entrance/exit to the Marina.
- Turn right at the entrance/exit onto Marine Crescent and walk back to the Royal Hotel.
